The Inglis and District Community Club is in the last year for the grow project. The parcel of land used is the same it has been in the past which is approximately 100 acres rented from Wilfred and Rita Wildeman and is south of their home yard. The project committee remained the same as it has been in the past which consisted of Kent Fingas, Luc Huberdeau, Ken Fingas, Dave Rowat and Lorne Frieze. It was decided to grow canola for the third and final year. The field was fertilized, seeded and sprayed by Ken Fingas. The dandelions were once again giving us some grief so two applications of glyphosate were used to hold them in check. The variety of canola that was sown was 45H28 which is a Round-Up tolerant variety. The crop looks quite good and we are hoping for a successful year once again. If you are going for a drive make a point of checking out the field to see the effort that has been put forward by numerous community volunteers to support this major fundraiser. We would like to give a special thank-you to the following:

Mid-Sask Ag - donating delivery of fertilizer to the field
Aaron Nerbas (Pioneer) -reduced price on the canola seed
Kenton Johnson (Monsanto) - 1st application of glyphosate
Brandy Beischer (Dow Agro Sciences) - 2nd application of glyphosate
Ken Fingas - reduced price on custom work (and willing to do it all which simplifies the whole process)

As a final note, the last of the wheat which was grown last year has been delivered and it ended up yielding an amazing 59 bus/acre. So as you can see from these figures, that truly is a major fundraiser. We will be planning a harvest/ picnic day this fall again so we'll keep you posted as the harvest day draws nearer.

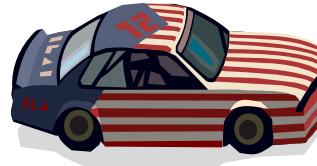
