Terinda Holopina is undergoing a Kidney transplant and her mom Barb is the donor.

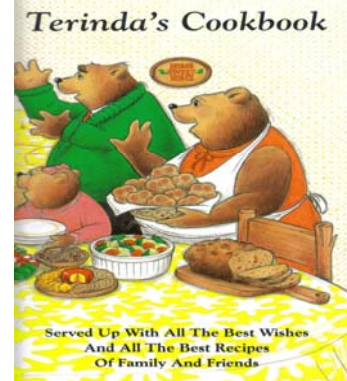
In June 2005, Terinda was diagnosed with a chronic kidney disease called juvenile nephronophthisis (degenerative disease of the kidneys). Since Terinda's diagnosis, they have made regular trips to the children's renal department at the Health Sciences Centre. They are currently doing a work-up for a kidney transplant.

They will be required to spend a lengthy stay in Winnipeg. This cost is not covered by insurance or our Medicare system.
