### ***Inglis School Asset-Building Project***

In January we will kick-off our asset-building project which will target the following three out of the forty developmental assets: Community Values Youth, Youth as Resources, and Equality and Social Justice. Asset-building is becoming an integral part of everything we do as we have realized how important this is in the development of our students.

We have many families in our area that have immigrated to Canada or who have different ethnic backgrounds. Nineteen of our sixty-three students, or 30% of our school population, have at least one parent or caregiver who is a first generation immigrant and many of these students were not born in Canada. We were recognized by Parent Magazine as being diverse or 'one-of-a-kind'. For this reason we felt that a Cultural Fair, or Folklorama, featuring these groups or families would give not only the students, but the community as well, a better understanding and knowledge of one another.

Students and staff will work closely with the families involved, learning as much about their culture as possible. We plan to feature a different culture every two weeks. This will include speakers and performances by guest dancers or musicians. We also want to include other cultural groups such as the First Nations, Romanian, Ukrainian, and Polish people. We hope to explore art, music, dance, and customs.

Our celebration of learning will be Folklorama which will be held in the Community Hall in March. It will be an opportunity to highlight these cultures, share what the students have learned, and promote a greater understanding and appreciation of our diverse community.
